

## SENTIMENTAL JOURNEY VENDORS

### TERMS AND CONDITIONS OF FLY-IN

Days & Hours of Operation: Fly-In begins on Tuesday, June 20th at 9:00am & ends Saturday, June 24th at 10:00pm.

Indoor vendors open from 9:00 A.M. to 5:00 P.M. each day of fly-in. Outdoor exhibitors' hours are from 9:00 A.M. to 8:00 P.M. Indoor Saturday hours are 9:00 A.M. to 3:00 P.M. We use the vendor building for the banquet on Saturday, therefore, everything must be out of the building by 3:00 P.M. We ask all vendors/exhibitors to keep their displays open, and not start to dismantle their exhibits until 2:00 Saturday afternoon.

#### GENERAL INFO:

Your commercial space fee will include 4 flight line passes, 1 auto parking permit, and free camping space, if desired.

An exhibit representative will be available the day before the fly-in to assist in locating your display area.

Your auto pass will allow parking in any one of the designated parking areas. Those with their exhibits outdoors may have their vehicles on site if it is essential to their exhibit. For reasons of safety, however, this vehicle must remain parked for the duration of the fly-in unless special arrangements are made with security.

#### NATURE OF EXHIBITS:

Exhibits should be of general interest, but not limited to the fly-in public. No items depicting the Sentimental Journey trademark or logo may be sold. Sentimental Journey reserves the right to bar any exhibit or part of an exhibit not in keeping with the character and purpose of the fly-in.

#### SECURITY:

Building is opened @ 9:00 A.M. and locked @ 5:00 P.M. No visitors will be permitted in the vendor building before or after hours. Sentimental Journey cannot, however, assume any type of liability for losses due to theft, fire, water, wind, or accident.

#### PUBLIC LIABILITY:

Exhibitors must ascertain that their public liability and employee compensation insurance policies include coverage of the public in their exhibit area, and all employees on the fly-in site.

#### NO SHIPMENTS TO SITE:

All shipments of display materials and sales items must be made to a cartage company or brought in by the exhibitor.

Arrangements must be made to pick up all exhibits and materials by 12:00 noon the day after the close of the show.

#### HOUSEKEEPING:

Exhibitors are responsible for their area. Housekeeping of the aisles will be provided by Sentimental Journey.

#### TAXES:

The state of Pennsylvania requires a 6% tax on all items that you sell. You are responsible for that.
